RE: Stolen Pharma Shipment

The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) received an alert from Healthcare Distribution Alliance's Pharmaceutical Cargo Security Coalition regarding a stolen pharmaceutical shipment. The shipment was stolen from a Jeffersonville, OH, truck stop on Tuesday, December 26, between 9:30 PM and 10 PM Eastern Standard Time.

There were 20 pallets of products in the trailer; following is a breakdown of what was stolen:

- Topiramate USP 25 mg, 50 mg, and 100 mg
- Albuterol Sulfate Inhalation Aerosol 9 mcg
- Meloxicam USP 7.5 mg and 15 mg
- Metoprolol Succinate ER 50 mg and 100 mg
- Sertraline HCl 25 mg and 50 mg
- Omeprazole/Sod Bicarb 40 mg/1100 mg Capsules, 30 count
- Vilazodone 20 mg and 40 mg Tablets, 30 count

The original responding law enforcement entity was the Fayette County Sheriff's Office. Also involved in this investigation is the Kentucky State Police Cargo Theft Unit, CI Analyst Gary Thomas, who can be contacted via phone at 859/293-4538 or via email at garyw.thomas@ky.gov.

Tractor Trailer Details

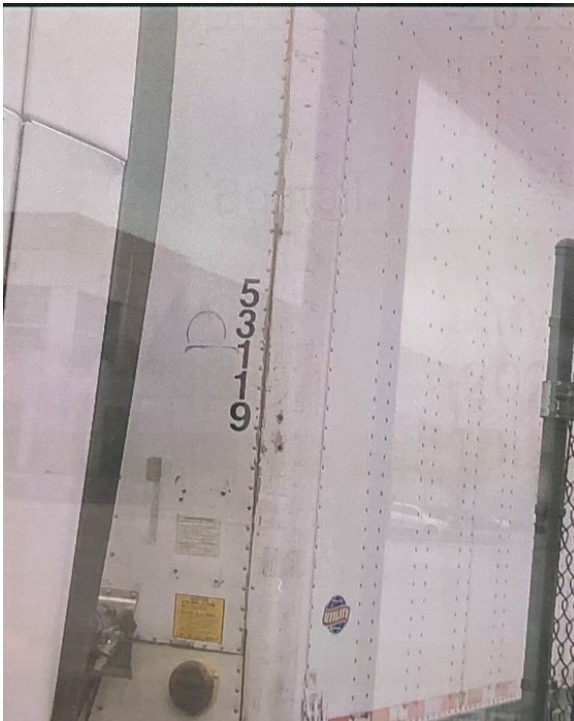
The original tractor was ultimately located approximately 11 miles from the site of the theft; the original trailer remains missing. Both units had GPS tracking technology; however, those units are believed to have been disabled after the theft.

- Trailer #: 53119 - Trailer VIN# 1UYVS25395P547511
- The trailer is solid white in color – no carrier name appears anywhere on that conveyance.
- The seal on the trailer was a cable seal. The number was: 716985

The shipment was double-brokered, with the last broker being Redwood Logistics. The carrier of record was A&D Carrier.
