

Company Settings


Company Settings allow the pharmacy to select how the data appears in the system, the type of validation errors to flag, and more. Company settings impact the entire company, regardless of location or user.



- To locate the Company Settings, select 'Manage Company' on the left-hand side of the Dashboard.
- Then select 'Company Settings'









GENERAL

- General settings include the Company name, contact phone number, & contact email.
 The pharmacy can make changes and select 'Save'
- User Session Timeout (minutes) is also an option under general settings. By default, a user will be logged off after 20 minutes of inactivity.
- To adjust the session timeout, select a different time from the drop down.




TRANSACTIONS

- By default, the system allows the user to mass accept & close transactions without opening or viewing them.
- By switching this setting to 'No', the user is required to accept each individual transaction.





- Under the 'Transactions' section, is a list of validation errors the pharmacy can select. By selecting the validation error, the pharmacy tells the system which errors to flag when the data enters the system. These errors then show up on the dashboard as well as are highlighted in red on the 'View New/Pending' screen
- Transaction missing product - product on the supplier's data does not appear on the finished transaction.
- Transaction Missing

- Product Missing NDC -NDC is missing



- Product Missing Description Product description is blank
- Product Missing Quantity this validation is for EDI and will show if a quantity is missing
- Product Lot Expires Within 6 Months identifies product that has an expiration date within 6 months or less of the transaction date.
- Product Lot Expires Within 12 Months identifies product that has an expiration date within 7–12 months of the transaction date.



Unchecking all of the boxes will turn off the data validation error alerts.


EPCIS FILE PROCESSING

 EPCIS File Processing determines how the transaction data is grouped on the transaction and plays key role in the pharmacy's receiving process.






 Under the 'Transactions' section, is a list of validation errors the pharmacy can select. By selecting the validation error, the pharmacy tells the system which errors to flag when the data enters the system. These errors then show up on the dashboard as well as are highlighted in red on the 'View New/Pending' screen



- GTIN Groups the data on the transaction by GTIN. Putting all items under a specific GTIN in one line
- GTIN & Container Groups the data by the highest level 'box' and puts each 'box' on its own line.
- GTIN & Lot Groups by the lot number putting all items under a specific lot number on one line.
- GTIN & Serial Number makes an individual line on the transaction for each serial number.



closed.


Hydroxyzine Pamoate
 Capsules have the same
 GTIN but are packaged in
 different boxes, the GTIN &
 Container setting will give
 each Hydroxyzine its own
 line item based on the box
 the product was
 packaged inside. Scan the
 box to accept the item.





 Ziprasidone HCL Capsule with 2 different lot numbers. GTIN & Lot will group the 2 bottles with the same lot number on 1 line and the other lot number on a different line. Accepting one accepts all the bottles with that same lot number.

Using GTIN & Serial
 Number, you can see
 each bottle of Ziprasidone
 HCL is listed on its own line
 - 3 bottles, 3 serial
 numbers. Accept each
 product individually.



• Which settings to choose is up to the pharmacy. Choose the settings that work best for your pharmacy's receiving process.

For best practices, InfiniTrak recommends the pharmacy use the following settings:

- Allow "Accept & Close" of transactions no
- Validation Errors check all of them and for expiration, select 6 months
- Group products by GTIN & Serial Number
